

# Wounded Warrior Pilot Program with the FBI



The Federal Bureau of Investigation is offering internship opportunities under the Wounded Warrior Pilot Program which was established on March 1st 2011. We are interested in identifying WWP candidates in the New Jersey area who are willing to participate on this internship and learn more about the FBI as well as gain valuable experience for future transition from the active duty service. The duties range from; logistical, IT, management, communications, training, intelligence analyst, investigative specialist, and many other. These candidates should have strong computer skills, ability to handle paperwork as well as good time management skills. We will train in specific functions.

In order for a Wounded Warrior to participate on the internship with us they must meet the following requirements;

- Be a U. S. Citizen
- Be in active duty and assigned to a Wounded Warrior Unit/Detachment/Regiment/Status
- Have at least 6 months remaining on the WW status
- Be able to attain a Top Secret Clearance (which we will conduct)
- Not have used any marijuana in the last 36 months
- Not have used anything stronger than marijuana in the last 10 years
- Not have used medication whether prescribed or not in a manner in which it is not intended for.
- Be cleared by DoD to participate in the internship
- Be able to get to and from the assigned office
